- One - \$10,000 Thomas Arkle Clark Graduate Scholar-Leader of the Year Scholarship
- One - \$10,000 James E. Foy - Jack Sagabiel Undergraduate Scholar-Leader of the Year Scholarship
- One - \$10,000 Centennial Scholarship (awarded to either a graduate or undergraduate student)
- Eight - \$7,000 Distinguished Member Graduate Scholarships
- Thirty-seven - \$5,000 Distinguished Member Undergraduate Scholarships
- Additional Elevations Scholarships will be awarded ranging from \$1,000 - \$4,500

Applications are considered for all awards the student is qualified for based on academic status.

Undergraduate and Graduate Applicants: Submit your completed application to the national office through this online form by **11:59pm (central daylight savings time) on May 1, 2026.**

The application is divided into six sections:




