






WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO JOIN?

Full-time students who have earned a GPA of a 3.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale in their first year.

WHAT SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AVAILABLE?

Phi Eta Sigma provides \$300,000 annually in scholarships from the national office. This includes two \$10,000 awards to our Scholars of the Year.
